La Secretaría del Organismo Internacional de Energía Atómica (OIEA) saluda a los Estados Miembros del OIEA y tiene el honor de señalar a su atención la celebración del **Taller Internacional para Concienciar a Funcionarios Superiores sobre las Medidas de Seguridad Física Nuclear para Grandes Eventos Públicos** (denominado en adelante el “evento”), que tendrá lugar en Valdemoro, Madrid (España) del **28 al 30 de junio de 2022**.

Además, se podrá participar en el evento de forma virtual a través de Cisco Webex.

La finalidad del evento es concienciar a funcionarios superiores sobre los sistemas y medidas de seguridad física nuclear descritos en la guía de aplicación del OIEA *Sistemas y medidas de seguridad física nuclear para grandes eventos públicos (Colección de Seguridad Física Nuclear del OIEA N° 18)*, y presentar los beneficios de aplicar estas medidas como parte de la seguridad física general de un Estado para grandes eventos públicos.

En la reseña informativa adjunta se ofrecen más detalles sobre el evento.

El evento se celebrará en español e inglés.

Se invita a los Estados Miembros a designar a una o más personas para que participen en este evento en representación de su Gobierno y se los alienta encarecidamente a que seleccionen con ese fin a mujeres cualificadas.

Por lo general, el OIEA no está en condiciones de sufragar los gastos de viaje ni de otra índole de los participantes en el evento. No obstante, dispone de fondos limitados para ayudar a cubrir los gastos de asistencia de determinados participantes. Esa ayuda puede ofrecerse normalmente, previa solicitud expresa, a un participante por país siempre que, en opinión del OIEA, la persona para la que se solicite pueda hacer una contribución importante al evento. La solicitud de apoyo financiero debe presentarse en el momento de la designación de los participantes mediante el formulario de solicitud de subvención adjunto (Formulario C).

Cabe señalar que el OIEA no paga ninguna indemnización por daños o pérdida de efectos personales. Tampoco proporciona seguro médico a los participantes en eventos del OIEA. Por lo tanto, se recomienda que estas personas adopten las medidas necesarias para contratar por su cuenta un seguro privado. No obstante, el OIEA cubrirá mediante un seguro los accidentes y las enfermedades claramente relacionados con los servicios prestados al OIEA.

Las designaciones deben presentarse al OIEA por conducto de la autoridad nacional competente (el Ministerio de Relaciones Exteriores, la Misión Permanente ante el OIEA o la Autoridad Nacional de Energía Atómica), a más tardar el **27 de mayo de 2022**, por medio del formulario de participación adjunto (Formulario A). ## **Information Sheet**

### **Introduction**

A major public event (MPE) is a planned national or international event, classified by the State as 'major', requiring implementation of a security plan. The organization of an MPE in which a large number of people congregate, such as a sporting contest or high-level political meeting (which could include high ranking State authorities), presents complex security challenges for the State hosting the event. Major public events draw great public interest and receive intense media attention. This makes them attractive venues for demonstrations, protests, violence, or any other action that can be made to bring awareness to a cause. One particular area of concern is organizations which might use these events as stages for criminal acts and acts of terrorism, including those involving nuclear or other radioactive material. It is recognized that not all MPEs are the same, and planning will vary based on threats, size, public perceptions, international awareness, and politics. However, there are common best practices that have been identified on the basis of experiences with the development of nuclear security systems for MPEs and these have been integrated into the event programme.

## Objectives

The objective of the event is to raise awareness among senior officials of States planning to host MPEs, of the nuclear security measures which can be implemented by their States to secure the events against nuclear security threats.

## Target Audience

Senior officials of organisations responsible for nuclear security at MPEs such as law enforcement, military, intelligence, technical support and similar security-focused organisations.

English and Spanish

## Participation and Registration

All persons wishing to participate in the event have to be designated by an IAEA Member State or should be members of organizations that have been invited to attend.

In order to be designated by an IAEA Member State, participants are requested to send the **Participation Form (Form A)** to their competent national authority (e.g. Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Permanent Mission to the IAEA or National Atomic Energy Authority) for onward transmission to the IAEA by **27 May 2022**. Participants who are members of an organization invited to attend are requested to send the **Participation Form (Form A)** through their organization to the IAEA by above deadline.

Selected participants will be informed in due course on the procedures to be followed with regard to administrative and financial matters.

Participants are hereby informed that the personal data they submit will be processed in line with the [Agency's Personal Data and Privacy Policy](#) and is collected solely for the purpose(s) of reviewing and assessing the application and to complete logistical arrangements where required.

## Expenditures and Grants

No registration fee is charged to participants.

The IAEA is generally not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the event. The IAEA has, however, limited funds at its disposal to help meet the cost of attendance of certain participants. Upon specific request, such assistance may be offered to normally one participant per country, provided that, in the IAEA's view, the participant will make an important contribution to the event.

The application for financial support should be made using the **Grant Application Form (Form C)** which has to be stamped, signed and submitted by the competent national authority to the IAEA together with the **Participation Form (Form A)** by **27 May 2022**.

## Visas

Participants who require a visa to enter Spain should submit the necessary application as soon as possible to the nearest diplomatic or consular representative of Spain.
