Purpose

The purpose of the event is to participate as attendees sponsored by the IAEA in the scientific and educational sessions of the XXVIII Congress of ALASBIMN 2021.

Working Language(s)

The working language(s) of the event will be **Spanish**.

Deadline for Nominations

Nominations received after **31 August 2021** will not be considered.

Information and Participation

This Congress is open to participants from the following countries participating in the IAEA technical cooperation programme RLA6083: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Uruguay and Venezuela. Countries may nominate more than 1 participant, who will be then selected based on the qualifications and experience described below.

- The participants shall have access to the full XXVIII Congress of ALASBIMN 2021 Online Programme.
- The participants shall be able to download the PDF files. The videos cannot be downloaded but may be viewed within the platform. The participants may download the lecture slide presentations by selecting the PDF button under Files. The participants may also download MP3 of the audio under Files.
- The XXVIII Congress of ALASBIMN 2021 Programme is automatically formatted to play on most mobile devices. ALASBIMN cannot guarantee compatibility with every mobile device, as operating system requirements are constantly changing.
- The attendee must be online to stream sessions on their mobile device. Sessions cannot be downloaded to mobile devices but will be available in the ALASBIMN website. Most sessions should work over 3G/4G, in addition to WiFi.
- The participants can attend the live virtual meeting (Sept 03–06, 2021), and they can also access the On-Demand product, which will remain in the ALASBIMN website for a full month.

Deliverable Data Items

The provider shall deliver the following data items:

The Contractor shall provide access to the Virtual Live congress to up to 500 participants.

After the Virtual Live ‘XXVIII Congress of ALASBIMN 2021’, by a to-be-agreed upon date, the Contractor shall make available the full content of the audio-video recordings, including the possibility to download the content, to participants registered for the XXVIII Congress of ALASBIMN 2021 Programme.

The user statistics, demographic information, and email details of the registrants of XXVIII Congress of ALASBIMN 2021 shall be provided in a data file, such as Microsoft Excel, and shall be sent to the IAEA within a period of two months, but not later than December 3, 2021.

Selection Criteria

Candidates must be nuclear medicine physicians, radiologists, medical physicists, radiopharmacists, nuclear medicine technologists, radiographers, or nurses. The candidates should have been involved in activities in this field at national level.

Application Procedure

Candidates wishing to apply for this event should follow the steps below:

1. Access the InTouch+ home page (<https://intouchplus.iaea.org>) using the candidate's existing Nucleus username and password. If the candidate is not a registered Nucleus user, she/he must create a Nucleus account (<https://websso.iaea.org/IM/UserRegistrationPage.aspx>) before proceeding with the event application process below.
2. On the InTouch + platform, the candidate must:
 - a. Finalize or update her/his personal details, provide sufficient information to establish the required qualifications regarding education, language skills and work experience ('Profile' tab) and upload relevant supporting documents;
 - b. Search for the relevant technical cooperation event (**EVT2104095**) under the 'My Eligible Events' tab, answer the mandatory questions and lastly submit the application to the required authority.

NOTE: Completed applications need to be approved by the relevant national authority, i.e. the National Liaison Office, and submitted to the IAEA through the established official channels by the provided designation deadline.
